

Postdoctoral position in Lattice gauge theory

The Lattice gauge theory group of Laboratoire de Physique Théorique d'Orsay (Damir Becirevic, Benoît Blossier and Philippe Boucaud) announces a 3-year postdoctoral position starting in Fall 2018, funded by Agence Nationale de la Recherche.

The applicants should work in the topics of lattice QCD and phenomenology beyond the Standard Model and have a high-quality research record. Their scientific interests should include lattice QCD, Higgs physics and flavour physics. They will have the opportunity to interact with phenomenologists from Laboratoire de l'Accélérateur Linéaire d'Orsay and Laboratoire de Physique de Clermont.
